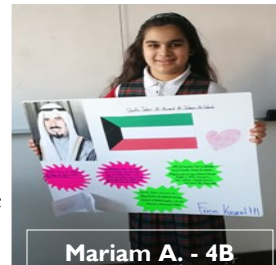

Social Studies

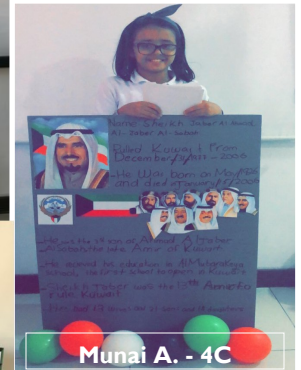
