Grade 2 Newsletter

This month our Math topics will be money and time. Children will understand the meaning and value of quarters, dimes, nickels and pennies. Students will know how to find the total of a group of coins and how to make different amounts using different coins. They will also learn how to count money over a dollar. We will start with the basics of telling time; the girls will be able to tell the time to the hour and half hour. They will be able to use A.M. and P.M. accurately.

In Social Studies, students will learn about different types of resources needed to produce goods. They will also study about the influence of different cultures of the immigrants on the American culture.

Grade 2 students will be continuing to learn about landforms and changes to landforms. We will then start a new topic about the nature of science, skills scientists need in order to collect data and about the technology we use in science.

In English Language Arts, we will start a story: A Big Bushy Mustache. Students will read the story, and answer comprehension questions about it. They will also learn how to use information to predict outcomes of a story. In grammar they will learn how to use ou, ow, ai, and ay patterns to decode words.



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
