## Language Arts

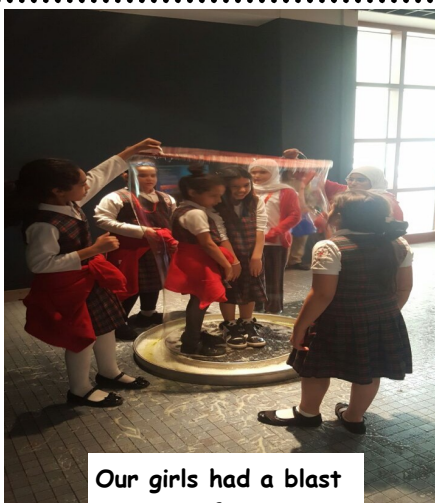

As we read, we will work on reading comprehension by focusing on making connections, questioning and determining importance. In our Grammar unit we will learn about verbs, root words and word changes in different sentence contexts to prepare for a Grammar test at the end of the month.

## Social Studies

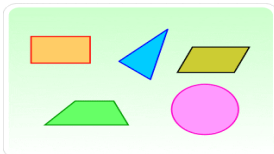
